From the classic myths of our ancestors, to Greek & Shakespearian Epics, and the contemporary myths found in superheroic sagas & swashbuckling "Space Operas", stories speak to the common values, aspirational truths, allegorical explorations and human themes upon which experiences are shared and communities are founded.

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# **Artistic Biography**

A California Young Playwrights Project finalist at age 18, winning production of his play "The Cultural Hyphen" at the Old Globe Cassius Carter Stage in 1994. From 1995 – 2005, served as Founding Artistic Director of the San Diego Asian American Repertory Theater producing ten seasons and over forty productions, workshops and staged readings. He continued to direct, produce and perform independently throughout San Diego with Asian Story Theater, SD Black Ensemble Theatre, at the Lyceum Theatre and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Theatre, while serving as founding program coordinator of the "Theatre-In-Residence Program" at the La Jolla Playhouse 2007-2012 and serving on various community boards such as the local chapter of OCA-SD, and the San Diego Alliance for Asian Pacific Islander Americans. It was also at this time that he founded Chinese Pirate Productions, independently producing special events, Staging for concerts and festivals, social media and marketing campaigns, as well as Producing & Directing independent musicals and theatrical productions. For his work he received two official mayoral commendations from the City of San Diego and was recognized in 2001's "Top 30 most influential Asian Americans Under the age of 30" by Political Circus Magazine. Andy left San Diego for Los Angeles in 2013, where he currently serves as Casting Director and Production Manager for the East West Players, the longest running theatre of color, and largest producer of Asian American work in the nation.
